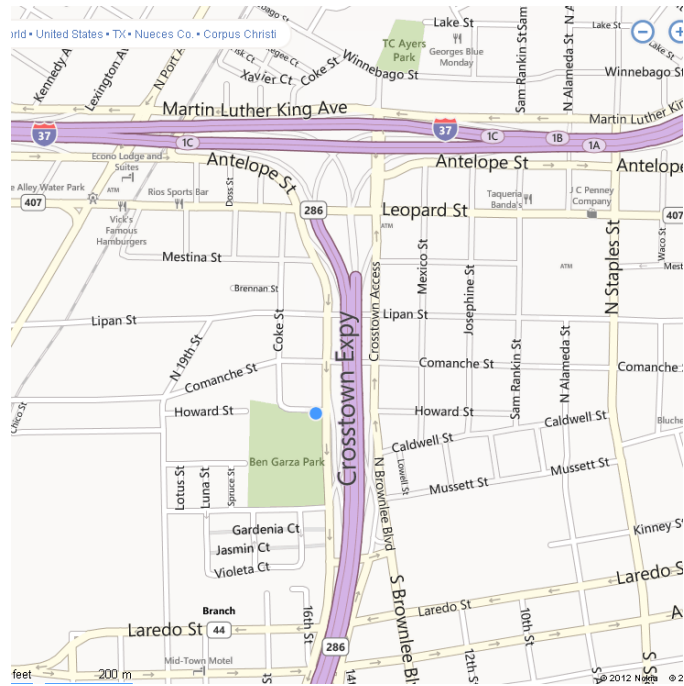

Games governed by USA Boxing Rules and Texas Amateur Athletic Federation

**Registration:**

- **Registration deadline:** Friday, July 12, 2013 (must be post dated by)
- Money must be sent with competitors list (NO CASH)
- Money orders and Checks – must be made out to: **PALS**
- NO REFUNDS – NO EXCEPTIONS
- Registration Forms and fees should be mailed to:

- All boxers must be currently registered with USA Boxing and bring their passbooks to the competition. THERE WILL BE NO REGISTRATION DONE AT THE TOURNAMENT.
- **NO PASSBOOK NO BOXING**

- Coaches must attend **MANDATORY MEETING** on Wednesday, July 26, 2013 at 5:00pm
- All coaches must be currently registered and certified with USA Boxing and have a RED PASSBOOK to work the corners. Coaches' registration WILL BE CHECKED.  
**No proof of current registration, no working the corner.**
- Boxer Weigh-ins:  
**All boxers must weigh in on Wednesday, July 26, 2013 and also weigh in on day of scheduled bout.**
- \*\*\*\*\***NO JUMPING WEIGHT CLASS**\*\*\*\*\*
- Wednesday, July 26, 2013 from 12pm – 4pm. This is the only day there will be a 4-hour time frame for weigh-ins.
- On Thursday (7/25), Friday (7/26), Saturday (7/27), and Sunday (7/28) all competing boxers on competing days are to report for weigh-ins at 7:30am. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
- The 2-hour window is for boxers that need to make weight.
- **LATE WEIGH-INS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED – BOXERS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED**
- Physicals: TBA at Coaches meeting
- Classification of boxers  
The following shall establish experience classifications:  
Novice Class. A boxer who has competed in 10 or less sanctioned USA boxing matches.  
Open Class. A boxer who has competed in more than 10 sanctioned USA boxing matches.  
Said boxer's 11<sup>th</sup> bout shall be in the open class.
- Masters Division 35 and older must provide their own headgear and will box with 16oz USA boxing approved gloves.
