- 1955 Sugar Bowl Meet New Year's - placed 1st in 440 relay and 2nd in mile relay in 3:16.3

- 1996 Selected as an official for the Olympic and Paralympics games in Atlanta

- 2004 Recognized for 50 years as official at the Texas Relays

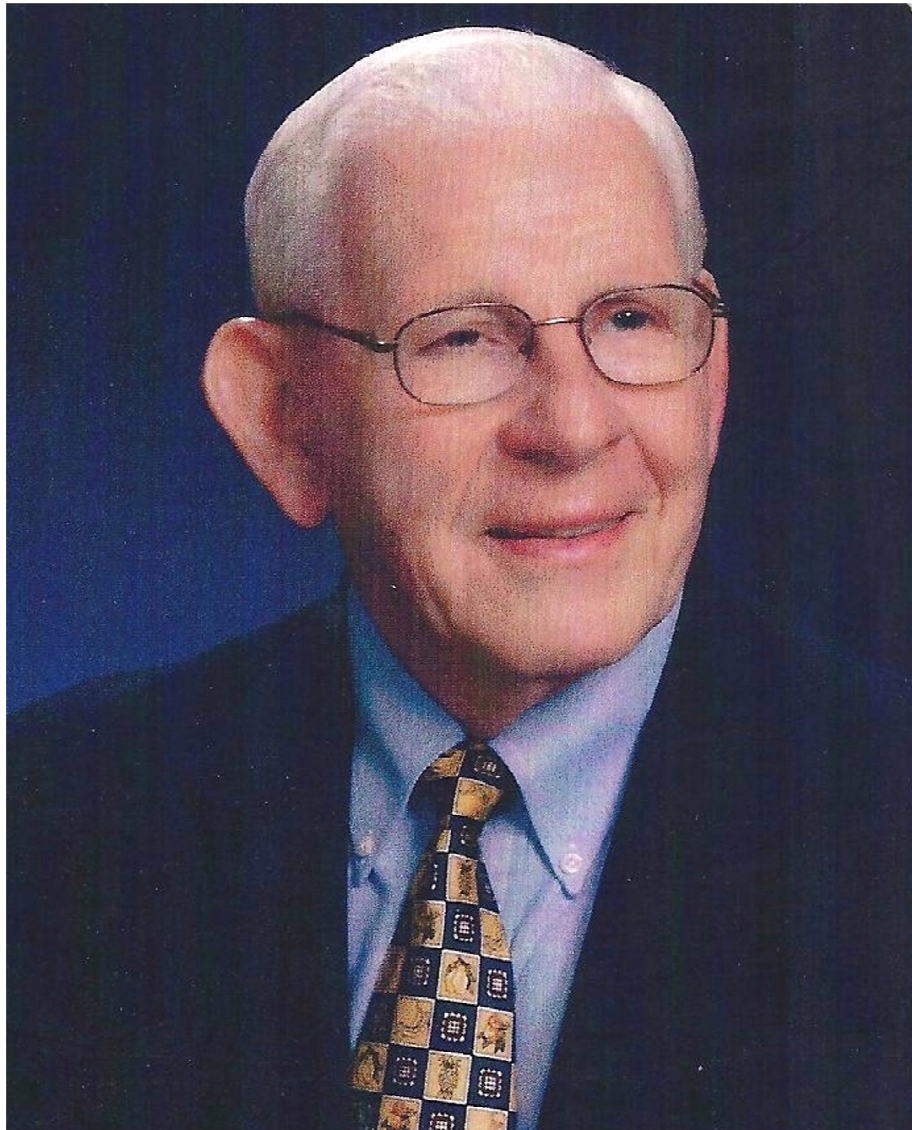
