2022 TAAF State Youth Basketball Tournament



- DATES:** March 18-20, 2022
- DIVISIONS:** Girls - 8, 10, 12, 14 & Under, Divisions I, II & III
- AGE GROUPS:** Age is determined by the participant's age on September 1 of the current school year. (9/1/21)
- ENTRY FEE:** \$300 per team
\$325 per team (Division I only, includes TAAF Registration Fee)
- ENTRY DEADLINE:** Thursday, March 10, 2022 by 5 P.M. Entry fee, entry form, certified TAAF team roster, and a copy of each player's birth certificate are due by the deadline

- FORMAT/BRACKET:** 3-game guarantee; pool play into single elimination bracket. Tournament brackets will be available on-line Wednesday, March 16 by 5:00 P.M. Brackets will be posted at www.teamsideline.com
- IMPORTANT NOTES:**
- Any coach who coaches more than one team has no guarantee that there will not be scheduling conflicts at some point in the tournament. All teams should be prepared to have an assistant coach in case of a scheduling conflict.
 - All registration paperwork, including your certified TAAF roster and copies of each player's birth certificates, are due by the registration deadline of 5 P.M. on Friday, March 10, 2022. Teams with incomplete paperwork will not be included on the bracket when schedules are completed, and refunds will not be issued.

- GAME TIMES:** All teams should be prepared to play on Friday. Based on the number of teams competing in the tournament, games MAY be scheduled to start on Saturday morning if possible.



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- GAME LOCATIONS:** The following age divisions will be playing at the following City.

- UNIFORMS:** Each team must provide their own set of uniforms with permanently fixed four inch (4”) on the front and a six inch (6”) on back per TAAF Cavalcade. T-shirts worn under the jersey must be matching for any players who wear undershirts. Tights and kneepads must be a single closely matching color for any players who wear them. Players who do not have the proper uniform will not be allowed to participate.
- EQUIPMENT:** The official game balls will be provided. Teams must supply their own warm-up balls.
- PROTEST:** All protests must be filed by the end of the game. Only a coach can file a protest. Judgment calls are not a basis for protests. You must notify the officials and scorekeeper so the protest is noted in the book. Please complete a protest form and submit with \$75 non-refundable fee in cash. Protests will be reviewed by the Protest Committee and the ruling will be final.

Championship Competition, and on behalf of myself, and my heirs, executors and administrators, in consideration of my participation in the T.A.A.F. Championship Competition, I hereby waive all claims against and release and hold harmless T.A.A.F., the sponsors of the T.A.A.F. Championship Competition (the "Sponsors"), and the host municipalities ("Hosts"), and their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, attorneys, successors and assigns, from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, causes of action, losses, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with my participation in the T.A.A.F. Championship Competition, including without limitation, death, any personal injuries or loss of, damage to or loss of use of property, which I may incur as a result of my participation in the T.A.A.F. Championship play and agree to be bound by the rules and regulation of T.A.A.F. as contained in the Cavalcade of Sports.

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Please note: The covid-19 guidelines are below for the City of Denton

I. COVID-19 Rules & Guidelines - To maintain the spread of COVID-19 and provide a safe environment for players, spectators, and staff. Please adhere and follow the requirements listed below.

- i. **Face coverings are required by all individuals at the Denton Parks & Recreation and UNT facilities while any city mandates are in effect.**
- ii. Participants, Coach's, and spectators should always self-monitor and check temperature at home prior to attending games. Noticeable concerns include: coughing, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, abnormal muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than 100.3 degrees. If any individual does not feel good or is showing any symptoms mentioned above. Please stay home!
- iii. Any individual whom has experienced any related symptoms or has been exposed to someone that has tested positive or tests positive CANNOT ATTEND games until cleared by a physician by providing a doctor's note and receive approval from DPARD to return. The individual MUST contact the Athletic staff immediately.
- iv. Should a player, coach (or multiple individuals) test positive for covid-19, DPARD will notify all participants who were in close contact with that individual. DPARD has the right to suspend or cancel the league due to covid-19.
- v. Teams will not be able to enter the gym until gym is empty from other team members. Please arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to your game. When games end, players and spectators should exit the facility immediately. Please do not congregate inside the. If you must wait for your double header game, please wait in car or come back closer to game time.
- vi. Please limit spectators to 1-2 per player. There is limited space available. Bleachers will be made available and will be first-come-first serve. Please maintain social distancing from others. Bleachers will be sanitized in between games.
- vii. Please avoid communal coolers. It is recommended that players and managers bring their own beverages to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
- viii. No spitting, or gum allowed. Individual in violation will be given 1 warning, after that it'll be subject to ejection of facility if deemed necessary by staff and/or referee.
- ix. Please practice social distance from one another.
