

Achievements, Honors and Awards:

- 1957-1959 Varsity Basketball, Lanier High School in San Antonio.
- Played basketball 3 years while in U.S. Army.
- Played & Coached in the San Antonio City Basketball League Major League division for eight (8) years.
- His team won the Regional T.A.A.F. Championship seven (7) of those eight (8) years.
- He was a player/coach in seven (7) T.A.A.F. State Championships.
- In 1969 his Saldana Food Stores team won the T.A.A.F. State Championship.
- His 1969-1970 team beat the Fort Sam Rangers, which were the US Army National Champions.
- His 1971 team beat the Lackland AFB, the Military Worldwide Champions.
- 1980-1981 Coached Professional Basketball team in Mexico.
- 1983 Represented San Antonio in International Tournament in Mexico City, finished
 2nd in tournament that included Olympic Teams from Mexico & Panama.
- 1987 Coached the Latinos in Action team, winning the National Mexican-American
 Tournament held in Los Angeles, California and Phoenix, Arizona.
- 1992 Inducted into the Mexican-American Hall of Fame, Laredo, Texas.
- In 1993 he founded the Latinos In Action Sports Association, a non-profit organization providing scholarships to needy high school seniors.
