TOURNAMENT RULES: Games are played under current Men's N.C.A.A. playing rules, with

some exceptions made by TAAF specifically for TAAF regional and state

basketball tournaments (see rules portion of this packet).

2023, and emailed to the listed coach/manager.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION: Please plan accordingly for road closures or detours.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: In the event of inclement weather, tournament information is updated

online at www.teamsideline.com/hurst.

ROSTERS: Rosters must be complete and submitted on an official TAAF roster

(attached). Additionally, rosters must be verified by the team's local

TAAF representative. Rosters are due at first game check-in.

PLAYER CHECK-IN: Check-in begins 45 minutes before the first game. Teams must check in

at least 30 minutes before their first game, and all players must present a valid Texas driver's license BEFORE playing in any game. A driver's license is needed to verify age. Any player that does not check in before

playing may be ejected from the tournament.

AWARDS: Team trophies are awarded to: State Champion, State Runner-up, and

Consolation Champion. Individual t-shirts for state champions and runner-up teams will be awarded. We ask all teams to remain in

uniform for trophy presentations and pictures.

ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS: Please call or email.

GENERAL REMINDERS: Players must have jerseys with the same base color. Jerseys must have a

permanently affixed, non-duplicated number on the front AND back. Jersey numbers must be one or two-digit numbers between 0 and 99.

Teams must turn in a completed, official TAAF roster before or at check-

in. Rosters should have a TAAF representative's signature.

Players must present a valid Texas driver's license before their first game to be eligible. No picture ID=No play. Players who fail to present

I.D. before playing may be ejected from the tournament.

Please read this packet carefully. Failure to prepare necessary items is

not an exception.

ROSTERS: Official T.A.A.F. Rosters, 12 players maximum.

RULES: All games will be governed by the 2021-2022 N.C.A.A. Rulebook and the 2022

T.A.A.F. Cavalcade of Sports with the following exceptions:

OFFICIAL GAME: An official game shall consist of two (2) twenty-minute halves with a running clock

for the first eighteen (18) minutes of each half. A running clock stops only for free throws and timeouts. An N.C.A.A. regulation clock will be used for the last two (2) minutes of each half. A regulation clock will stop for all whistles in the last two (2) minutes of each half and each successful field goal in the last one minute of the

second half or overtime period.

FORFEIT TIME: The official game clock is located in the Recreation Center Office. Each team must

have five eligible players on the floor at game time. <u>Time outs may be used to allow for players to arrive</u>. Timeouts are taken in their entirety (30 seconds or 1 minute); partial timeouts are not allowed. Officials will have the authority as to

when a forfeit will be called, and their decision shall be final.

HALF TIME: A five (5) minute half-time is observed.

TIME-OUTS: Teams will be allowed four (4) one (1) minute timeouts and two (2) thirty-second

timeouts per game.

OVERTIME: Each overtime will consist of a three (3) minute period with the clock stopping for

all whistles during the entire period. Each team will be allowed (1) full timeout.

Teams will lose any timeouts they had remaining at the end of regulation.

JERSEYS: Players on each team must wear jerseys that are similar in the base color of the

jersey and must have a six (6) inch number on the back and a four (4) inch number on the front. Numbers must be permanently affixed to the jersey, not taped or pinned to the jersey. Numbers handwritten in pencil, marker, or ink pen will not

be allowed.

GAME BALL: The City of Hurst will provide game balls. Teams should bring and use their own

balls for warm-ups.

POINT RULE: A point ahead rule of twenty (20) points will be used in all adult basketball games.

If a team is up by twenty (20) points, the clock will not stop except for injuries and timeouts until the team ahead is ahead by less than twenty (20) points or the clock is stopped by a timeout. The clock will stop the last 2 minutes of each half

for all whistles and made shots.

SHOT CLOCK: The five-second closely guarded while dribbling violation will be in effect for all

T.A.A.F. Adult Basketball State Tournament basketball games as a result of the

absence of a shot clock for T.A.A.F. Championship play.

EJECTIONS: Any player or coach ejected from a game during the tournament for

unsportsmanlike conduct will not be allowed to play or coach for the remainder of the tournament and must <u>leave the facility</u>. The Tournament Committee

reserves the right to adjust suspensions if circumstances warrant.

TECHNICAL FOULS: Two (2) technical fouls on any one (1) player for unsportsmanlike conduct

constitute an **EJECTION** of that player from the game. **Three (3) technical fouls** for unsportsmanlike conduct on any one (1) team constitute a forfeited game.

LINE-UPS: Line-ups must be recorded in the official scorebook TEN MINUTES before the

scheduled game. Line-ups should include each player's first and last name and

jersey number.

IDENTIFICATION: Team check-in will begin 45 minutes before the day's first game. Each team will

need to check in, turn in the roster and pick up shirts. Each player must be able to produce a valid driver's license or official picture identification at any time during the tournament. Players must be 35 or older at the beginning of the

tournament.

RECREATION CENTER: The Hurst Recreation Center is open to our members during the tournament. We

ask all players and spectators to be respectful. Players/spectators cannot utilize

the facility unless they are members or pay the daily rate.
