- 4. You still have to have a minimum of three meets ij the season and at Least ONE of your meets must be after the season midpo
- 5. Level OO is now simply Level 9
- 6. Xcel Sapphire has also been added.
- 7. There is no minimum score to move up to a higher level. We are relying on the professionalism and knowlege of the coach to for the athlete, however, moving backward is still not an option.

Well, that's it for right now. Register and set your meet schedule. Get your background checks done now - no reason to wait. So delays so be sure you are on top of that as well. As always, email me with any errors you may find or if you have questions. I'll b
